



2010 HUNGER-RELATED STATE LEGISLATION

AB 537

AUTHOR: Arambula (D-Fresno)

TITLE: EBT at Farmer's Markets

SUMMARY: Establish EBT acceptance at Farmer's Markets across the state.

AB 963

AUTHOR: Ammiano (D - San Francisco)

TITLE: Medi-Cal and Food Stamps

SUMMARY:

This bill creates an advisory committee to make recommendations to align reporting and recertification processes for Medi-Cal and Food Stamps.

AB 1198

AUTHOR: Swanson (D-Oakland)

Title: Food Stamps for Recovery

SUMMARY:

Fully remove life-time ban on former drug felons who have gone through recovery.

AB 1642

AUTHOR: Beall (D - San Jose)

Implementing simplified reporting for the food stamp program.

AB 2018

AUTHOR: Skinner (D-Berkeley)

TITLE: Food Stamps: Intercounty Transfer Study

SUMMARY:

Relates to food stamps and the intercounty transfer of benefits. Requires a study to explore the annual cost savings that an ICT process for food stamp benefits that is consistent with the process for CalWORKs, IHSS and Medi-Cal may provide.

SB 1322

AUTHOR: Liu (D-Los Angeles)

TITLE: Food Stamp Employment and Training Program

SUMMARY:

Requires a county to screen work registrants to determine whether they will participate in, or be deferred from, the Food Stamp Employment and Training program.

Establishes various categories of individuals who are deferred from mandatory participation in the program. Requires that when an individual is sanctioned for failing to comply with the work requirements of the CalWORKs program, that the individual would not receive a food stamp sanction.

SB 1359 & 1453

AUTHOR: Curren Price (D-Los Angeles)

TITLE: Public Social Services: Food Stamps

SUMMARY:

Repeals provisions requiring the Food Stamp program to implement CalWORKs reporting requirements. Imposes requirements for semiannual reporting for the Food Stamp program. Deletes fingerprint imaging requirements with respect to applicants and recipients under the Food Stamp program. Prohibits eligibility for food stamps from being conditioned on the limitation of an individual's or family's assets.

SB 1413

AUTHOR: Leno (D)

TITLE: Schools: Food Service Areas: Water

SUMMARY:

Amends an existing law that permits the sale of only certain beverages to pupils at schools. Requires a school district to provide access to free, fresh drinking water in school food service areas by a specified date.

AB 1914

AUTHOR: Davis (D-Los Angeles)

TITLE: Public Social Services: Emergency Food Stamps

SUMMARY:

States the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation that would require the state to provide emergency food stamp benefits to those waiting for their unemployment benefits or an extension of unemployment benefits to become available.

AB 2720

AUTHOR: Perez (D - Los Angeles)

TITLE: Public Health: Food Justice

SUMMARY:

Provides recommendations to the Legislature regarding actions that need to be taken to promote food justice in the state.

AB 2504

AUTHOR: Strickland A (R)

TITLE: CalWORKS Eligibility: Fraudulent Representations

SUMMARY: Relates to CalWORKS eligibility and fraud.
