

Job Title: **Warehouse Supervisor**
Reports To: Operations Director
Classification: Regular, Exempt, Full-Time
Schedule: Monday to Friday, 6:30am 3:00pm

This position supervises the day-to-day operations of the Food Bank's Solano warehouse team and operations, as well as organizes and maintains inventory and storage areas.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Directly supervise the work of 6 warehouse staff members.
- Work closely with the Remote Distribution Coordinators to prepare agency orders for shipment. This includes pulling the orders, staging to be verified, verified, wrapped and loaded.
- Manage the flow of product for the order pullers. Keeping proper stock on the floor, ensuring pallets and products are tagged.
- Keep up with the routine demand of agency orders of 150 per week, and the increased demand of the holidays up to 240 per week.
- Receive all inbound loads of produce, USDA, purchased food and program fund food items, up to 15 truckloads a week.
- Work with Program Coordinators to ensure boxing projects are ready for volunteers.
- Work with the Remote Distribution Coordinators for cycle counts and perform monthly USDA inventories as well as year-end inventory.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- 2+ years' experience in a warehouse supervisory role preferred.
- Experience supervising and directing the work of a team required.
- Ability to prioritize and manage multiple tasks and projects while meeting strict deadlines.
- Working knowledge of inventory control practices utilizing inventory control software.
- Strong computer skills, including Microsoft Excel.
- Experience in safety management preferred
- Ability to identify and resolve problems in a timely manner, develop alternative solutions, and use reason even when dealing with emotional topics.
- Valid California Driver's license and insurance, required.
- Ability to occasionally lift up to 50 pounds.
- Ability to pass a drug screen, background screen, and be covered under the Food Bank's auto insurance policy.
- Forklift experience preferred.
