



## Applications will be accepted February 6-9, 2018 and February 12-14, 2018

You may be eligible for Disaster CalFresh food assistance (also known as D-SNAP or D-CalFresh) if your household:

- Lived in or worked in the following disaster areas: Santa Barbara or Ventura, on December 4, 2017 or January 8-9, 2018; and
- ◊ Experienced a disruption in income; or
- Had damage to your home or self-employment property; or
- Had disaster-related expenses; and
- ◊ Is not already receiving CalFresh food assistance.

Note that there <u>is</u> a household income limit. For example, a household of 2 may qualify for a one-time benefit of **\$352** if their monthly gross income is less than \$2,049 after considering disaster related impacts, including lost income and disaster-related expenses.

## Individuals and families that are ineligible for regular CalFresh may be eligible for Disaster CalFresh food assistance based on qualifying disaster-related expenses.
