



Pandemic EBT 4.0

Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) 4.0 was a disaster response program intended to support school-aged children and young children under age six who lost access to free or reduced-price school meals due to facility closures, a transition to a virtual learning model, or absences from school due to COVID-19 illness during the months of August 2022 through May 11, 2023, the end of the Public Health Emergency (PHE). P-EBT 4.0 also authorized summer benefits for eligible school-aged children for June 2023 through August 2023.

P-EBT 4.0 was administered by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) in partnership with the California Department of Education (CDE).
